

The Great WILD WEST Ranger Derby



**All cars must be
Wild West-themed
to be eligible to
enter.**



The cars for your outpost need to be made before arriving at camp. You will have to do some work with your boys ahead of time. Help them pick their design and have fun building it with them. Please let your boys do the majority of the work so they can live the Adventure.

Racer Specifications

Width – 2 ¾”

Weight – 5 ounces (maximum)

Width between wheels – 1 ¾”

Bottom clearance between car and track – 3/8” (minimum)

All racer bodies must be made of wood

All cars must be inspected and cleared by the Ranger Derby Committee to be allowed to race and to be eligible for any prizes. If a car does not pass inspection at registration, the owner will be informed as to the reason for failure. Owners will be given time during the weigh-in to bring their car into specs. Failure to do so within the registration time will result in that car not

being able to participate. Pay attention to the rules as you help your boys build their car. Check the schedule for Ranger Derby Racer Inspection time.

Allowed

Only Ranger Derby wheels & axles

Only dry lubricant

Details, such as steering wheel & driver

(not to exceed maximum length, width, weight)

Prohibited

Car's front end cannot extend past the starting pin

Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings

Car shall not ride on springs

Must be freewheeling, no starting devices

All Ranger Kid racers will race.

All other categories are only allowed one racer per outpost. So, choose your racers wisely!

All boys and Commanders can enter their car for Best in Show even if they are not the outpost racer for an age group, as long as they have their car inspected and meet Racer Specifications. There is no limit to the number of cars that an outpost can have for Best in Show.
