

About the SSAC:

- a. Participants will report to the Springville Camp and Conference Center (SCCC) mid-morning but not later than 10:00AM on Friday, 16 FEB 2024.
- b. Participant lodging will be in the (SCCC) with bed linens, and towels provided.
- c. Food will be provided by the SCCC. Meals begin with lunch on Friday, 16 FEB 2024 and end with breakfast on Monday, 19 FEB 2024.
- d. Students will be able to earn the Smallbore Safety merit.
- e. Students will be able to earn the Shotgun Safety merit.
- f. Students can complete the NRA Basics of Rifle Shooting course.
- g. Students can complete the NRA Basics of Shotgun Shooting course.
- h. Classroom training will be held (principally) at the SCCC.
- i. Rifle and shotgun shooting will take place at the Muzika Range Complex at Camp Lone Eagle.
- j. Each participant will receive hearing and eye protection which must be worn at all times on the active shooting ranges.
- k. All training and range operation will be under the oversight of Certified Instructors and Range Safety Officers, respectively.
- l. Participants will receive an SSAC T-shirt.
- m. Upon completion of all the SSAC activities, each participant will receive an SSAC patch.
- n. Upon completion of the camp, participants will be available to depart from the SCCC by 11:00AM on Monday, 19 FEB 2024.
- o. Boys and men will interact in patrol activities during the course of the SSAC.
- p. Boys and men will have opportunities for spiritual growth through personal devotions, group devotions and special services.
- q. Firearms and ammunition will be provided for participants to use as a part of the event. Participants should NOT bring their own firearms or ammunition to the SSAC without prior approval by John Brown who can be reached at 931.347.7444 (call or text).
- r. Participants should plan to dress warmly for outdoor range activities.
- s. Participants should bring their own camp chair and water bottle for use at the range.
- t. The number of participants for the SSAC will be limited to 12, so please register as soon as possible; don't delay.
