COVID-19 Event Protocols



Screening • All participants must be screened for COVID-19 exposure *prior to traveling* to or upon arrival to Alabama AG District events using the questionnaire available at adcag.org/resources. Each person is required to complete the form within <u>twenty-four hours</u> prior to arriving to an event or upon arrival to an event. Completed forms will be collected upon arrival to any event. *If a participant answers* <u>YES</u> to any of the questions on the COVID-19 questionnaire, they should not attend in person. Many of our events will be available online.



Medical Personnel • Personnel will be on site to oversee temperature screenings, COVID-19 questions and medical issues (applicable to large events).



Temperature Checks • All participants may be asked to submit to a touch-less temperature check upon arrival at the event. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be isolated for further medical evaluation.



Masks Required • In the spirit of cooperation with government authorities, masks will be required in all shared spaces when social distancing is not possible (indoors and outdoors) unless otherwise requested. Children under 2 are exempt from wearing a mask.





Group Distancing• (When applicable) Participants are strongly encouraged to remain with the group they traveled to the event with. Each group should plan to stay together when possible for the duration of the event.



Altar-in-Place • Consider the place where you and your group are located to be your altar. Remain in place with your group and pray together during altar and prayer times.



On-Site Food Service• (Where applicable) Participants should stay with their groups during meals. Groups should be seated to maintain distancing.
